Landscape Update

The final tree maintenance work for the year has been completed, except for some stump grinding. In addition, we have planted two new trees; a coral bark maple along the Reston Pathway as it approaches the golf course between Courtyards B and C beside 2152, and a willow oak in front of 2139 in Courtyard F.

The first leaf collection of the year is scheduled to be done in the next week or so. A second collection will be done in mid-December. Residents are required to rake up and dispose of the fallen leaves on their own property. They can be bagged or put in trash cans and put out for any regular trash collection.
